<i>Heterotexus pezzizus</i>	Jelly Bells	jelly	wood	Small shallow bells on twigs.
<i>Laccaria</i> spp. x2		gills	soil	Orange caps, gills and stem
<i>Lepista nuda</i>	Wood Blewitt	gills	soil	Lilac mushroom, edible. Fungimap target.
<i>Lepiota</i> sp.		gills	soil	1 small specimen
