## **Report on previous activities**

- Excursion to Weecurra & Wilkin 30 September –see attached
- <u>Wannon Flora Reserve control of Acacia paradoxa</u> the acquittal report on this massive Landcare project has been submitted to GHCMA and SGSC. Thanks to the Landmate crew from Ararat, and especially Andrew Levings and his team, the entire reserve has been cleared of large pest shrubs. HFNC volunteers and students from Baimbridge College have worked on removal of seedlings and small shrubs. We have the job before us to remove emerging seedlings in coming years.
- <u>Weed work at Nigretta Flora Res</u> on Sunday 12 November 3 members completed the removal of African Weed Orchid (and worked on Cleavers and Phalaris), with the surprisingly low total for the year of 835 AWO (compared with many thousands in previous years). What will next year bring?
- Excursion to Wannon and Nigretta Falls Rock pools on Saturday 18 November see attached
- <u>Beear State Forest fauna nest box inspection</u> on Sunday 26 November 4 members and 2 visitors enjoyed a fine day at Beear. We found Sugar gliders in 2 of our 7 functional boxes. Twelve years ago we set up 10 boxes but now most are showing signs of decline; 2 have collapsed and bees have taken over one. Where to with that project?
