Flags seen on Sanderlings on Killarney beach

- 19 Sanderlings were seen to have flags on their legs. The combination of orange (on tibia) and yellow flag (on tarsus) on the right leg indicate that the birds were flagged after April 1999 in SE of South Australia, 205 km from Killarney.
- 2 Sanderlings with metal band on left leg tarsus and yellow flag on right leg tarsus indicate the birds were flagged in NW Australia after Aug 1992, 2910 km from Killarney.
- 1 Sanderling with metal band on left leg tarsus and white flag on right leg tarsus indicate the birds were flagged near Auckland in NZ, after Dec 1991, 2870 km from Killarney.
